While the VP/ix™ release that accompanies 386/ix™ Release 2.0 is still termed Release 1.1.0 of the VP/ix Environment and is essentially the same as that which accompanied 386/ix Release 1.0.6, some important bug fixes have been made:

- Lotus® 1-2-3®, Version 2.0, would not pass copy protection. It now does.
- MS-DOS® (DOS) record locking (INT 21, func 5C) would not work in many cases; this kept a number of DOS applications that were meant for multi-user environments from working correctly. This has been fixed.
- The Microsoft® serial mouse would not work using the driver supplied with MS Windows™; after some time, VP/ix would exit fatally. This was especially noticeable under heavy system load. This no longer occurs.

In addition to bug fixes, support has been added for the following PC-compatible serial terminals: the IBM® 3151 and the Kimtron KT-70/PC®. Support for these terminals has been added to 386/ix as well. The correct TERM values for these terminals are `ibm3151` and `kt70`, respectively.
