NCR 399 New Product Announcement

In February 1973, NCR released two more peripheral devices for the 399 Accounting Computer that moderately extend the I/O handling capabilities to greater speeds for printing and magnetic ledger card handling.

NCR 314 MAGNETIC LEDGER FEEDER/READER: Reads and transmits data from 11-inch magnetic-stripe ledger cards at up to 47 cards/minute. The 314 connects directly to the NCR 399's interface board without tying up a common trunk position. First customer shipments of the 314 are scheduled for the second quarter of 1973.

NCR 349-300 LINE PRINTER: Prints 132-position lines with a 64-character set at a horizontal spacing of 10 characters per inch and a vertical spacing of 6 characters per inch. The 349-300 is an extension of the earlier 349-100 (125 lpm) and 349-200 (200 lpm) printers; like them it includes its own controller for attachment to the NCR 399 through a common trunk position. First customer shipments of the 349-300 are scheduled for the second quarter of 1973.
