Problem

It's been reported that line feeds generated during run time cause an I/O ERROR CODE 30 when, in fact nothing is really wrong.

* * THE FOLLOWING PATCHES ARE REQUIRED! * *

Solution

The problem may be corrected by applying the following patches on your Model I and Model III COBOL.

At TRSDOS READY key the following:

PATCH RUNCOBOL/CMD (ADD=A5F4,FIND=28,CHG=18) PATCH RUNCOBOL/CMD (ADD=A602,FIND=28,CHG=18) PATCH RUNCOBOL/CMD (ADD=A612,FIND=C2CEA6,CHG=ØØØØØØ) PATCH RUNCOBOL/CMD (ADD=A642,FIND=CA, CHG=C3) PATCH RUNCOBOL/CMD (ADD=A653,FIND=C2CEA6,CHG=ØØØØØØ) PATCH RUNCOBOL/CMD (ADD=A665,FIND=CA,CHG=C3)

After applying these patches, line feeds to the printer will not cause I/O ERROR 30 to appear without a valid reason.
