Problem

INV allows user to change a stock number when quantity on hand is not equal to zero.

Solution

The problem is corrected by following the steps listed below.

1. Backup the diskette(s) and make the changes on the Backup copy of the program.
2. In BASIC load the program by typing LOAD"IMS/BAS".
3. Make the following corrections:
