WESTERN UNION MODEL 32 TELEX TELEPRINTER

The model 32 is the most popular Telex teleprinter.

Both the printing and dialing mechanisms are contained in one compact, modern-looking unit. It is used for both the transmission and reception of messages and data.

Transmission is direct from the keyboard (KSR) or from either the keyboard or transmitter using a pre-prepared paper tape (ASR). Tape is prepared off-line in the "local" position. An incoming call pre-empts a "local" connection. Tape may also be prepared "on-line" of that which is being sent or received.

During transmission, both the sending station and the receiving station print the message. On the same connection, a station's keyboard and transmitter may be used alternately but not simultaneously. Similarly, the calling and called station may transmit alternately but not simultaneously.

FEATURES:

Answer-back: Identifies the receiving station and the city where it is located. Each station's answer-back code is unique.

"Who Are You?" key: Actuates answer-back of distant station to verify correct dialing.

"Here Is" key: Actuates sender's answer-back to identify sender's station.

Dial Control Unit: Establishes connection with other stations on Telex network.

Control Lamps and Buttons: Control sequential steps to obtain connections.

Copy Holder: Holds messages awaiting or during transmission (mounted on rear of unit).

Automatic answering: Turns on receiving station by remote signal.

Dual disconnection: Initiates signal to disconnect circuit (at either end).
